



Sexual Purity Course Lesson 18

Scripture: Read Proverbs 6:20-7:27.

Study:

1. How are fire and sexual sin alike (6:27-29)?
2. In 7:4-5 the young man is pictured as choosing between two women. Who are they? How does the first woman keep the young man from the second?
3. How does the adulterous woman attract the young man? What arguments does she present to him? Answer in your own words.
4. How is the young man's heart involved in the temptation? How are the young man's activities, environment, and surroundings involved in the temptation?
5. What do all of these things have in common: an ox being led to slaughter, a bird rushing towards a snare, and the young man who goes after the adulterous (7:21-23)?

Application:

1. What truth is this entire section sensitizing the reader to? Try to summarize the main point of this section on adultery into one simple sentence.
2. The adulterous woman gave reasons why the young man should sin with her. Consider the arguments that your particular temptation speaks to you. How does it call out to you and attempt to justify itself? Write out the lies that it tells you.
3. For each of the lies given in the previous point write out the truth that you should respond with.
4. Memorize Proverbs 6:32.
