

**Scripture:** Read 1 Corinthians 7:1-9 and Hebrews 13:4.

## **Study:**

- 1. Summarize the teaching here on remaining single.
- 2. What does the word of God say that a man or woman should do "because of the temptation to sexual immorality"?
- 3. Does the Bible suggest that sex within marriage can act as a preventative against sexual immorality? Explain.
- 4. Under what circumstances is it proper for a husband and wife to abstain from sex with each other? Explain each of the qualifications.
- 5. How is the issue of sex within marriage a matter of spiritual warfare?

## **Application:**

If you are married, then talk to your spouse about this passage. Use this assignment as your reason to bring it up. Honestly discuss these questions:

- 1. Do you have the sense that my body belongs to you?
- 2. What time frame do you think of when you read the words "limited time" (vs. 5)?
- 3. Have we allowed Satan to bring temptation into our marriage?

If you are single, make sure that in your search for a spouse you stick closely to God's word: "Do not be unequally yoked with unbelievers. For what partnership has righteousness with lawlessness? Or what fellowship has light with darkness? What accord has Christ with Belial? Or what portion does a believer share with an unbeliever" (2 Corinthians 6:14-15).
