



## Sexual Purity Course Lesson 6

Throughout this series we will have exegetical and topical studies. This study covers some of the most important topics in all of Scripture. It is about loving God and living for His glory.

**Scripture:** Read Deuteronomy 6:4-5; Matthew 22:34-40; John 14:15; 1 Corinthians 10:31; and 1 John 5:1-3.

### **Study:**

1. What does it mean to love God with all your heart, soul, mind, and strength?
2. In what way is this commandment the first and greatest commandment?
3. How is love, for God, properly expressed?
4. What does it mean to live for God's glory?

### **Application:**

1. Your motives matter. You must have the proper reason for seeking after sexual purity. The desire for sexual purity must flow from a deep and intense love for God and a genuine desire to glorify Him in every aspect of your life. Other factors may be involved, but your highest motive must be to live a life that is pleasing to Him. Take time to weigh your motives. Challenge and eliminate self-seeking motives. If your heart is cold or even indifferent toward God, then you are breaking the first and greatest commandment. Take time to confess, repent, and reorient your heart to God.
2. Why do you love God? What about God's character causes you to love Him? What about God's work of salvation causes you to love Him? What about God's providence in your life causes you to love Him?
3. Memorize the following from the Westminster Catechism:  
Q1: What is the chief end of man?  
A1: Man's chief end is to glorify God, and to enjoy Him for ever.
