Q6: What did Jesus accomplish by His resurrection? Connect the dots from His resurrection to our salvation.

Q7: What is the theological significance of the ascension? Connect the dots from His ascension to our salvation.

Read: Chapter 29: The Offices of Christ

Q8: Define the offices of prophet, priest, and king, as they relate to Jesus.

Q9: What are the practical implications of having Christ as our prophet, priest, and king? In other words, explain how He uses each office for our benefit.

Read: Chapter 30: The Work of the Holy Spirit

Q10: Each person of the Godhead has specific activities to carry out. What does the Holy Spirit do in the outworking of the plan of redemption? Use Scripture in your answer.
